WARNING AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACTION

To the Legal Occupier,

You are hereby notified that if you are using television receiving equipment to watch or record television programmes at the above address, you are acting in contravention of the Communications Act 2003.

According to our records, there is still no TV Licence at the above address. Furthermore, we have received no response from you to our previous communications. Therefore we have no choice but to investigate.

Authorisation has been granted for Enforcement Officers to visit your property in order to determine whether equipment such as the following is being used illegally:

- A colour or black and white television;
- Video or DVD recorder;
- Set-top box;
- A computer.

If evidence is found that any such equipment is being used on your property without a licence, you will be cautioned and your statement may be taken, in compliance with the relevant criminal law*. This is the first step in our action to prosecute if an offence is suspected. We take TV Licence evasion very seriously, and last month alone we caught 33,781 evaders.

I strongly advise you to visit www.tvlicensing.co.uk or call the Payment Helpline on 0870 241 7204 immediately and buy a TV Licence.

A TV Licence costs £131.50 for colour and £44 for black and white, and can be purchased by monthly, quarterly or yearly Direct Debit, debit or credit card or cheque. (Payment options and exclusions overleaf)
