TV Licensing Officers will soon be visiting

To the Legal Occupier.

You do not have a TV Licence - you must take steps to avoid further action.

After repeated reminders that this address is currently unlicensed, we have still had no response from you. If you watch or record television programme services without a valid TV Licence it is against the law and we now suspect you of wilful evasion of payment.

It would be wise for you to take steps to avoid legal action.

You may not realise that our Enforcement Officers have been catching far more people recently because:

- · Using sophisticated equipment on unlicensed households, we can identify if a TV is being watched within
- In addition to making daytime visits, they're now authorised to visit you in the evenings and on weekends.
- . They can apply for a search warrant to enter your home; and have the right to examine and test any television receiving equipment located on the premises.

Avoid the risk of legal proceedings and a fine of up to £1000 by calling 0870 241 7204 to discuss your licensing requirements or to pay for your licence immediately. Alternatively you can pay online at www.tvlicensing.co.uk

A colour TV Licence costs £131.50 and there are a variety of ways to pay. More information is available below and on the reverse of this letter.
